The Springfield / Clark County Baseball Hall of Fame, with the approval of the Harvey Haddix Family, will market 1,000 Limited Edition Harvey Haddix Bobblehead Dolls. The dolls, which will be numbered and are approximately 8" tall.

Harvey was elected to the Springfield / Clark County Baseball Hall of Fame in 1960 and gained fame nationwide as the pitcher who in 1959 threw 12 perfect innings in a major league game.

The doll is handpainted and looks similar to the way Harvey did the night he pitched this historic gem. The rear base of the doll reads "The Kitten", Harvey's nickname throughout his career.

Proceeds from the sale of the dolls will be used by the Hall of Fame to purchase a scoreboard for the new "Municipal Stadium" being constructed by the National Trail Parks and Recreation District in Springfield, Ohio.
