### Site Amenities

- Golf

### Unique Characteristics/Observations

- Shared site for open space and golf
- Open space is not easily accessible
- Not well integrated into the neighborhood
- Shared public open space adjacent to golf course

### Recommendations

- Location and private nature of the space provides excellent opportunity for district nursery operations
- Convert open space to district nursery and maintenance headquarters
- Use existing structures when possible for office/storage space
- Provide staging areas for bulk materials such as mulch and top soil
- Provide staging areas for temporary plant storage
- Expand irrigation system
- Provide vehicle and equipment storage
- Create a more secure entry point/gate at E. Leffel Lane entry
- Formulize management plan
