Unique Characteristics/Observations

- North anchor of the Buck Creek Scenic Trail
- Provides mostly passive recreation
- Confusing vehicular circulation
- Used heavily for fishing
- Abandoned bridge at Pumphouse Road still serves bike trail

Recommendations

- Create a new two-way entry drive
- Remove one-way exit drive
- Dredge pond/lagoons and create a single body of water
- Improve the inlet control device at Buck Creek
- Improve and or repair the outlet/overflow mechanism
- Construct accessible pier/boardwalk for fishing
- Improve parking areas along main entry drive
- Remove loop road
- Remove existing maintenance building
- Consolidate maintenance into single building
- Improve parking and screening adjacent to maintenance building
- Improve parking lots used for trail users
- Upgrade play equipment
- Improve bike trail along west bank of pond
- Improve northwest parking lot
- Construct northeast parking lot for fishing and/or picnic area
- Formalize management plan
